Theme: Seasons

Mathematics-Number sense

Introduce preschool children to the concepts of addition and subtraction through literature, songs, and games. Stories, songs, and games provide a playful way to introduce "adding-to" and "taking-away" operations, and part—whole relationships. Experiences with concrete sets of objects, in particular, can illustrate for children addition and subtraction concepts and enable children to solve simple addition and subtraction problems by counting objects. *(CA Preschool Curriculum Framework, Volume 1, Mathematics-Number Sense, page 255)*

Ask questions that encourage purposeful counting. Use counting to determine quantity and answer a child's question within context: "I wonder how many petals that flower has? Four, five, six?" To compare two quantities, the parent might ask, "Which bed/couch has more pillows? How many has more/less?" To create a set with a number of objects, the parent could suggest, "the table needs four spoons." Or to solve addition and subtraction problems, ask "How many spoons do we have altogether? How many are left?" Combine counting with pointing or touching objects to reinforce the concept. To add in the theme of seasons you can talk about what happens outdoors during springtime...the weather changes.....flowers begin to bloom...animals are born...birds began to sing...then follow up with songs that introduce children to counting concepts.
