<u>Instruction</u>

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Instruction in physical education shall be provided for a total period of time of not less than 200 minutes each 10 school days. (Education Code §§51210, 51223)

Physical Performance Testing

Students in Grade 5 shall undergo the physical performance testing designated by the State Board of Education on an annual basis. Students with a physical disability and students who are physically unable to take all parts of the test shall undergo as much of the test as their physical condition will permit. (Education Code 60800)

Students shall be provided with their individual results after completing the physical performance testing. The test results may be provided orally as the student completes the testing. (Education Code 60800)

Each student's scores on the physical performance test shall be included in his/her cumulative record. (5 CCR 1044)

The Board shall report the aggregate results of its physical performance testing administered in their annual school accountability report card. (Education Code 60800)
