- The program is open to credentialed CVESD teachers in need of a clear credential or in their first year of teaching. Please note, teachers hired after the first quarter of the school year may enroll the following school year based on employment.

The CVESD Induction Program engages preliminary credentialed teachers in a job-embedded system of support and professional growth to fulfill the requirements for clearing their California Multiple Subject, Single Subject, and Education Specialist credentials.
