### Business and Noninstructional Operations

### **CLAIMS AND ACTIONS AGAINST THE DISTRICT**

The Governing Board desires to conduct District operations in a manner that minimizes risk, protects District resources, and promotes the health and safety of students, staff, and the public. Any and all claims for money or damages against the District shall be presented to and acted upon in accordance with the Government Claims Act or other applicable state or District procedures, as well as the District's joint powers authority (JPA) agreement or other insurance coverage.

(cf. 3530 - Risk Management/Insurance) (cf. 5143 - Insurance)

Any claim for money or damages not governed by the Government Claims Act (Government Code sections 810-996.6) or specifically excepted by Government Code 905 shall be presented and acted upon in accordance with District-established procedures consistent with the manner and time limitations specified in the accompanying Administrative Regulation, unless a procedure for processing such claims is otherwise provided by state or federal law or regulation. (Government Code section 935)

Upon notice to the District of a claim, the Superintendent/designee shall take all necessary steps to protect the District's rights under any applicable contractual agreements, including the right to indemnification from its insurance or other coverage provider.

In accordance with Government Code section 935.4, the Board delegates to the Superintendent/designee the authority to perform all functions of the Board permitted by section 935.4, including the authority to reject or allow, compromise, or settle claims of \$50,000 or less pursuant to any conditions of coverage in the District's JPA agreement or insurance coverage.
