Student Awards and Incentives

The Governing Board encourages excellence as a goal for all students and wishes to publicly recognize students for unique or exemplary achievements in academic, extracurricular or community activities.

Awards may be offered when the principal deems them to be reasonably achievable and when there is an equitable opportunity for attaining the award.

Student awards may include verbal recognition, a letter, certificate, a public ceremony, or a sum of money. They may also receive free merchandise or services, not dependent on a minimum purchase. Discount awards on merchandise or services should not be accepted.

In cooperation with staff and the community, the principal will approve or reject proposed trophies, prizes, or other awards. The purpose of any such proposed award must be consistent with school goals. Criteria for presenting the award must be acceptable to the principal.
