<u>Instruction</u>

GIFTED AND TALENTED STUDENT PROGRAM

In order to meet the needs of students who have demonstrated potential ability for high performance, the District shall participate in the California Gifted and Talented Pupil Program.

The District program shall identify students in one or more of the following gifted and talented categories:

- a. Intellectual.
- b. Creative.
- c. Specific academic or leadership ability.
- d. High achievement.
- e. Talent in performing and visual arts.

Gifted and talented programs may offer differentiated instruction within classes; parttime grouping, enrichment activities; cluster grouping; independent study; acceleration; services for underachieving, linguistically or culturally divergent and/or economically disadvantaged eligible students; and special instruction not offered in the regular classroom.

The Superintendent or designee shall establish procedures which ensure parent/guardian participation in planning, evaluating, and implementing the program. (Education Code 52208)
